The 'Kintbury Experience' is a time of laughter and tears, games and social time, stories shared alongside prayers, reflection and celebration. Some 40 years on the work and ministry continues.

How the 50★50 Club works

To enter our monthly draw simply sign up to pay £5.00 each month, which will give you one unique number for the monthly draw. You can buy more than one ticket to increase your chances of winning.

For example, if you want to donate £20.00 each month you would have 4 unique numbers.

You must however be over 16 years old and you can stop whenever you choose. (See Rules of St. Cassian's 50★50 Club.)

Joining the 50★50 Club is extremely easy, relatively low cost, but something that makes a big difference to St. Cassian's.

How does St. Cassian's benefit?

Half of all the proceeds raised by the club are then allocated to St. Cassian's Development Fund. The other half is retained as the prize fund. The more members we have the bigger the prize fund and the more charitable donations are received towards St. Cassian's.

There will be 3 winning numbers picked at random on the last working day of each month. 50% of the monthly subscriptions shall remain with the charity and 50% will make up the prize fund:

1st prize: 30%; 2nd prize: 15%; 3rd prize: 5% .

How to join in the fun!

To join, you need to be over 16 years of age. Please complete and return the application form, which includes the standing order bank instruction. The monthly entry fee will then be paid to us each month direct from your bank and we can allocate you with your unique number/s and get you started! We'll write to let you know your lucky number(s).

The first draw will take place at the end of January 2017.

After the draw, we'll post the winning numbers on our website (but not names or personal details) and we'll contact the winners to tell them the good news!

Rules of St Cassian's 50★50 Club

1. St. Cassian's 50★50 Club will be run to benefit the St. Cassian's Centre Development Fund.
2. Subscription to the Club shall be a minimum of £5.00 per month, per membership, payable by standing order, and making payments deems that participants agree to St. Cassian's 50★50 Club Rules. Participants may also pay annually in advance .
3. Individuals may have multiple subscriptions. Each £5.00 donation will entitle the member to a permanent unique number.
4. You must be over 16 years old to become a member.
5. There is no limit to the number of members the St. Cassian's 50★50 Club can have.
6. The 50★50 Club will commence in January 2017, providing a minimum of 20 (draw numbers) have been allocated and paid for by the date of the first draw. If the 50★50 Club does not run then any amounts received in respect of the 50★50 Club will be refunded.
7. All members are eligible for inclusion in the monthly draw as long as the subscription for that month has been paid in advance (by the 15th of the month).
8. In the event of non-payment by the due date, membership of the 50★50 Club will be terminated with immediate effect.
9. There will be one draw per month.
10. The draw will take place on the last Friday (or working day) of each month.
11. 50% of the monthly subscriptions will make up the prize fund and 50% shall remain with the charity.
12. All reasonable efforts will be made to pay or post prizes within one week of the draw.
13. Results of all draws will be binding and final.
14. Under no circumstance can subscriptions be refunded.
15. Personal details will not be passed on to any third party without permission. All data is processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.
16. St. Cassian's can terminate the 50★50 Club at any point in time; any overpayments made by participants will be refunded by St. Cassian's Centre.
